**AGREEMENT**  
**BETWEEN**  
**BC PARKS AND THE HEATHENS MOUNTAIN CLUB**

PROJECT Adopt the Crest Creek Crags trail network in Strathcona Provincial Park

BC PARKS AGREES TO:

- complete any major repairs or additions to facilities at the Crest Creek Crags,
- supply the guidelines to which the trails in the area are to be maintained,
- supply hand tools for the use of volunteers on the trail and any required training,
- supply Park standard signs, posts and other materials for approved improvement projects,
- ensure regular communication is maintained with the adoptee,
- supply volunteer insurance for all those working on the trails,
- supply first aid equipment when available, to meet the Occupational First Aid regulations.

HEATHENS MOUNTAIN CLUB AGREES TO:

- maintain trails in the Crest Creek Crags area to agreed upon standards by: brushing out trails, providing drainage/water bars where needed, clearing minor windfalls, removal of litter, minor facility repairs, trail surface work, repairs to signs,
- ensure that all volunteers working on the trail have signed a volunteer agreement with BC Parks,
- ensure that all volunteers' hours are recorded,
- inspect the area trails a minimum of 2 times per season,
- ensure that all major improvements/projects have been approved by BC Parks and the Crest Creek Planning group,
- adhere to all Occupational First Aid regulations and BC Parks' Occupational Illness and Injury Prevention Program.
- ensure that all trail maintenance is carried out in a safe manner,
- contact BC Parks prior to work parties commencing to arrange adequate first aid equipment.
